NICOLAS MARTIAU SERVICES

Known as "The Adventurous Huguenot," Nicolas was born in France in 1591, came to the Jamestown Colony aboard the "Francis Bona Venture" in 1620, and died at Yorktown, Virginia in 1657. He was a Captain in the Indian uprising at Falling Creek, a member of the House of Burgesses, Justice of the County of York. In 1635, he was a leader in the thrusting out of Governor Harvey which was the first opposition to the British Colonial Policy. Nicolas is the original patentee for Yorktown. Descendants are traced through his daughters: Mary m. Col. John Scarsbrook, Sarah m. William Fuller and Elizabeth m. Col. George Reade. Nicolas Martiau was the earliest American ancestor of both General George Washington and Governor Thomas Nelson (a signer of the Declaration of Independence).
